BYLAW NO. 14639

A BYLAW to designate the “Eagle Ford” neon sign
as a protected heritage property

WHEREAS the “Eagle Ford” neon sign (hereinafter called the “Sign”) is or will be located on and attached to the City-owned sidewalk on the north side of Hastings Street located adjacent the property located at 4160 Albert Street (alias 4191 Hastings Street);

AND WHEREAS Council considers that the Sign, which was installed in the 1940s or 1950s outside of the property historically addressed 4161 Hastings Street (now 4160 Albert Street) where it remained for over 40 years and became a landmark of the local “Heights” business area, is valued for its original design and its landmark location on Hastings Street;

AND WHEREAS Council considers the Sign to have heritage value and heritage character, and that designation of the Sign pursuant to section 611 of the *Local Government Act* is necessary or desirable for its conservation;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY HERITAGE DESIGNATION BYLAW NO. 1, 2024.**
2. Council hereby designates the Sign as protected heritage property under section 611 of the *Local Government Act*.
