CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 9945

A BYLAW to provide that the most current available Provincial list of voters prepared under the Election Act be the register of resident electors.

WHEREAS Section 60 of the Municipal Act empowers the Council by bylaw to provide that the most current available Provincial list of voters prepared under the Election Act is to be the register of resident electors;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY PROVINCIAL VOTERS LIST ADOPTION BYLAW 1993.**

2. For the purposes of all municipal elections under Part 2 of the Municipal Act, including submissions to the electors, the most current available Provincial list of voters prepared under the Election Act shall become the register of resident electors on the 52nd day prior to the general voting day for any such election.
