

CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 10605

A BYLAW to provide for the establishment of metered parking on certain streets

(Consolidated for your convenience with Bylaw No. 10948, 11696, 13508, and 13700)

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY PARKING METER BYLAW 1998**.

2. In this Bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

“metered space” means an area of the curb lane of a street for the parking of a single vehicle and for which a parking meter has been installed pursuant to this Bylaw; (BYLAW No. 13700)

“metered zone” means any street or portion of a street designated as a metered zone in Schedule “A” of this Bylaw; (BYLAW No. 13700)

“motorcycle” means a motorized vehicle that runs on two wheels; (Bylaw #11696)

"park" means the stopping or standing of a vehicle, whether occupied or not;

“parking meter” means a mechanical, electronic or automatic device installed in a metered zone pursuant to this Bylaw for the purposes of identifying a parking space as a metered space and, where payment is made to the parking meter by cash or credit card, measuring and indicating the time during which a vehicle may be parked in a metered space; (BYLAW No. 13700)

“pay-by-phone system” means a telecommunications system approved by the City for accepting the payment of the fee for parking a vehicle in a metered space and measuring the time during which a vehicle may be parked in a metered space; (BYLAW No. 13700)

"vehicle" means a device in, on or by which a person or thing is or may be transported or drawn on a street or highway, except a device designed to be moved by human power or used exclusively on stationary rails or tracks, and includes a motorcycle.
(Bylaw #11696)

3. The City’s Director Engineering is hereby authorized and delegated the authority to:

- (a) designate metered spaces within the metered zones;
- (b) install and maintain parking meters in respect to the metered spaces; and

- (c) establish rules and regulations in respect to the metered spaces, including without limiting the generality of the foregoing, the hours during which parking fees apply, maximum consecutive period for the parking of a vehicle in a metered space, and the size or type of vehicle permitted to be parked in a metered space.
(BYLAW No. 13700)
- 4. No person shall park a vehicle in a metered space without immediately:
 - (a) depositing cash in or paying by credit card to the parking meter installed for such space the fee for parking in such space; or
 - (b) paying through a pay-by-phone system the fee for parking in such space,at the rate set out on the parking meter, subject to the maximum rate in Schedule “B” of this Bylaw; (BYLAW No. 13700)
- 4A. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), not more than one vehicle shall be parked in a metered space.
- (2) Not more than three motorcycles may be parked in a metered space.
(Bylaw #11696)
- 5. No person shall park or permit a vehicle to remain parked in a metered space:
 - (a) where payment is pursuant to section 4(a) of this Bylaw, when the parking meter indicates that the time, as measured by the parking meter, for the parking of the vehicle in the metered space has expired; or
 - (b) where payment is pursuant to section 4(b) of this Bylaw, when the time period for the vehicle to be parked in the metered space, as measured by the pay-by-phone system, has expired.
- 6. No person shall park a vehicle in a metered space
 - (a) at any time when the parking of vehicles at that location is otherwise prohibited;
or
 - (b) when the parking meter is not functioning.
- 7. The Director Engineering may temporarily discontinue the use of a metered space for the parking of vehicles and may place at such metered space a sign indicating that parking is not permitted at that metered space and no person shall park a vehicle in such metered space while such sign is so placed.
- 8. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a vehicle in a metered space except as permitted by this Bylaw.

9. The owner of a vehicle parked in contravention of this Bylaw shall be liable for the penalties provided for any violation of this Bylaw with respect to the vehicle, but nothing in this section shall relieve the operator of a vehicle from incurring the penalties provided for such violation.

10. Every person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction and shall be liable to a fine not exceeding \$10,000, and each day that the offence is continued shall constitute a separate offence.

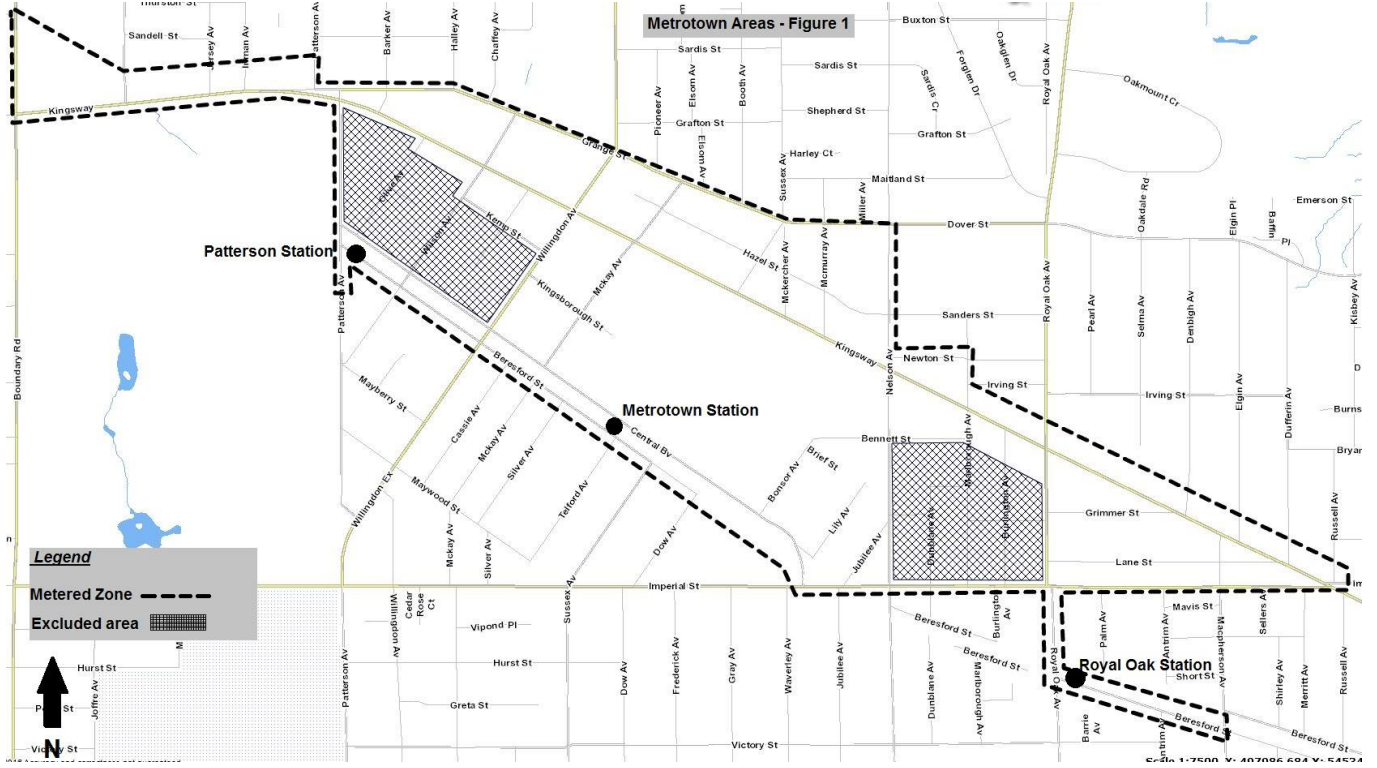

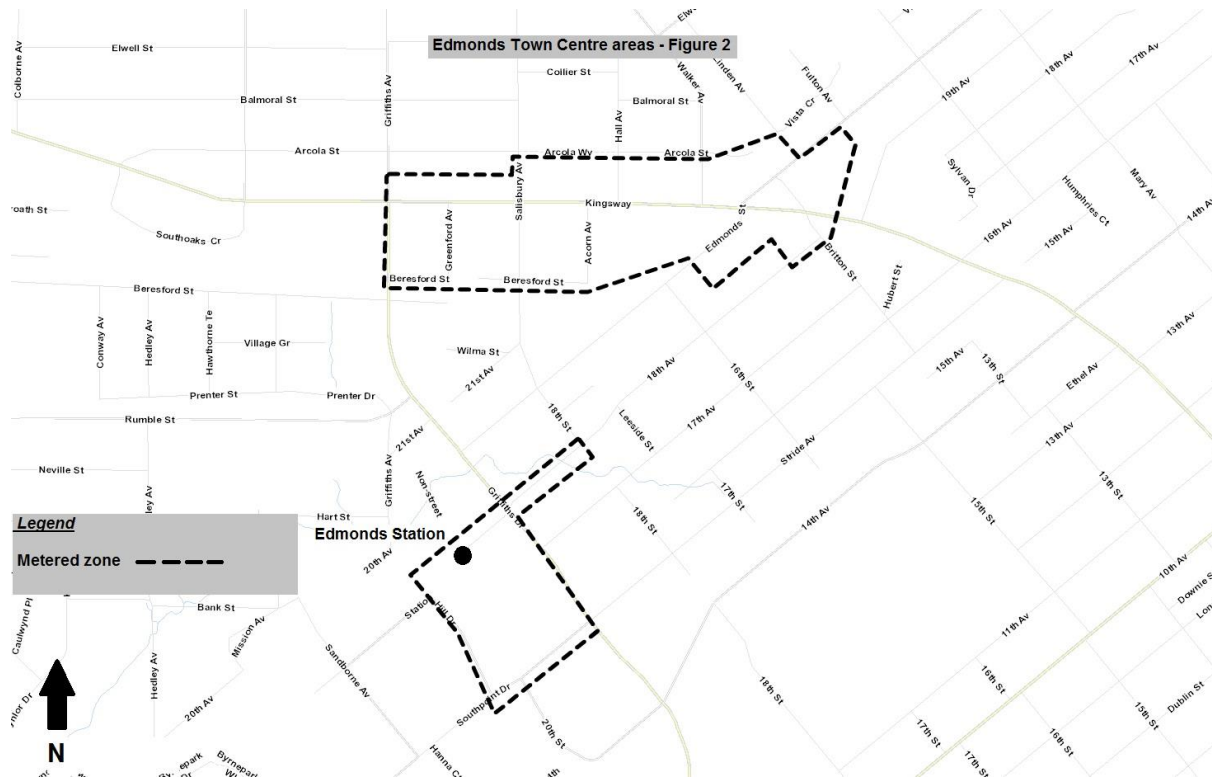

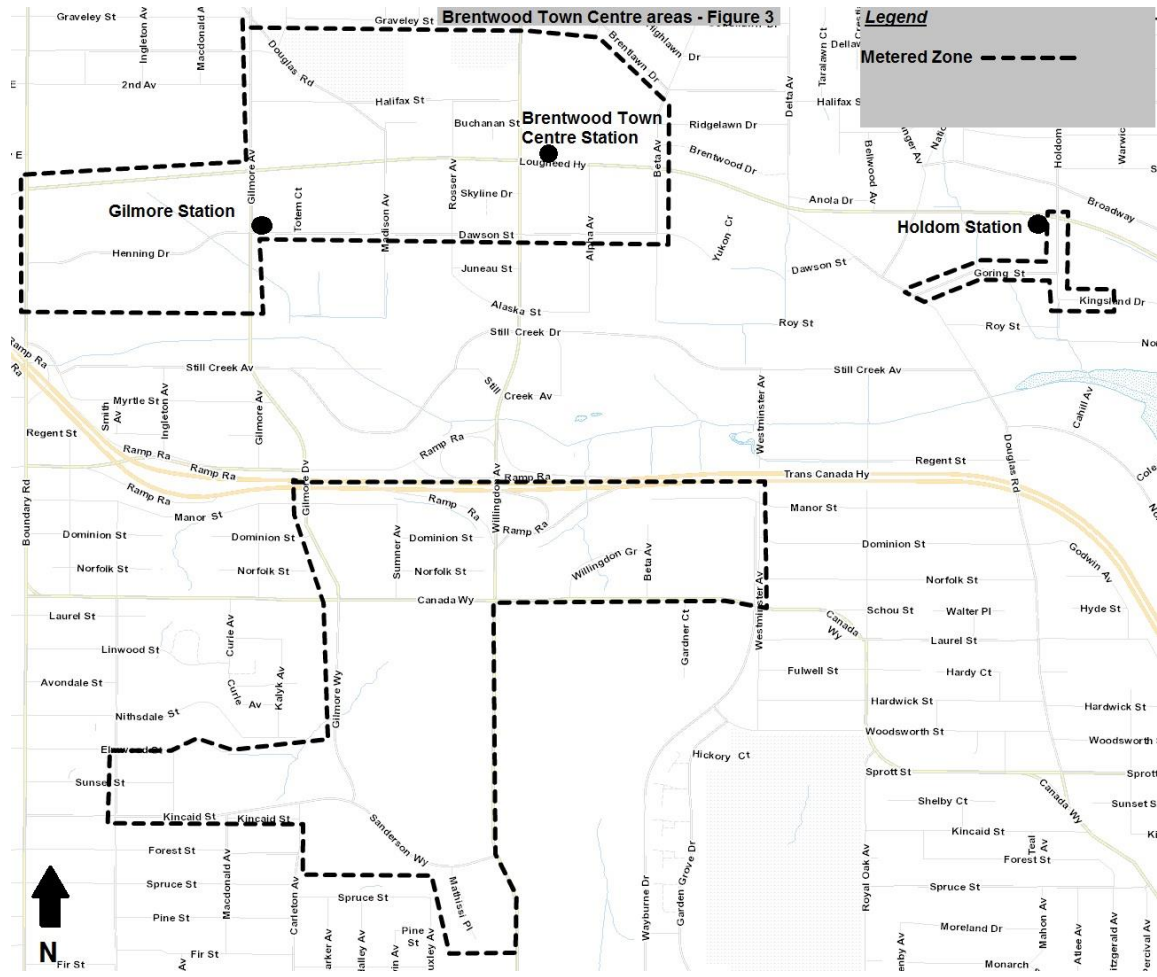

METERED ZONES

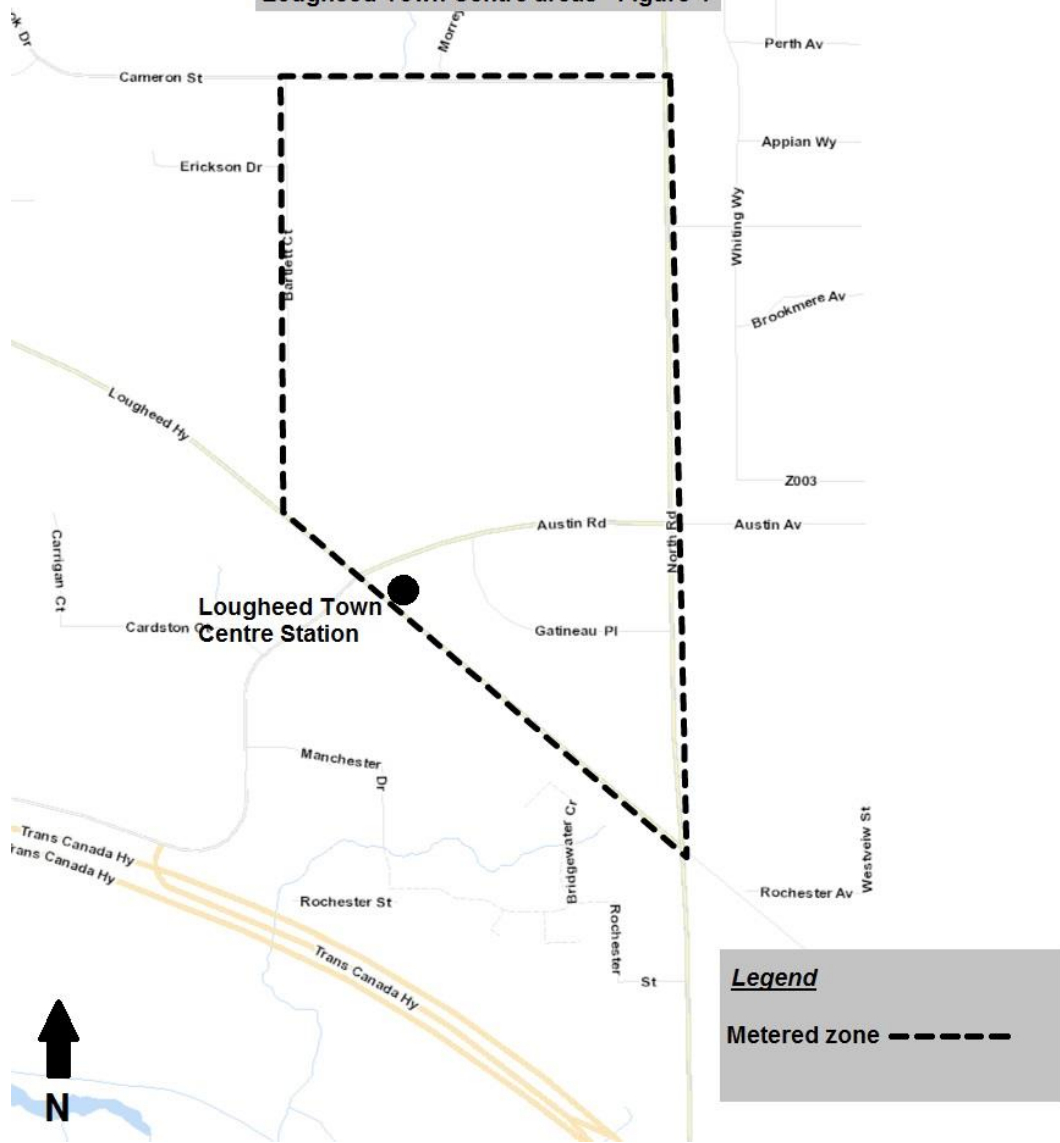


Edmonds Town Centre areas - Figure 2

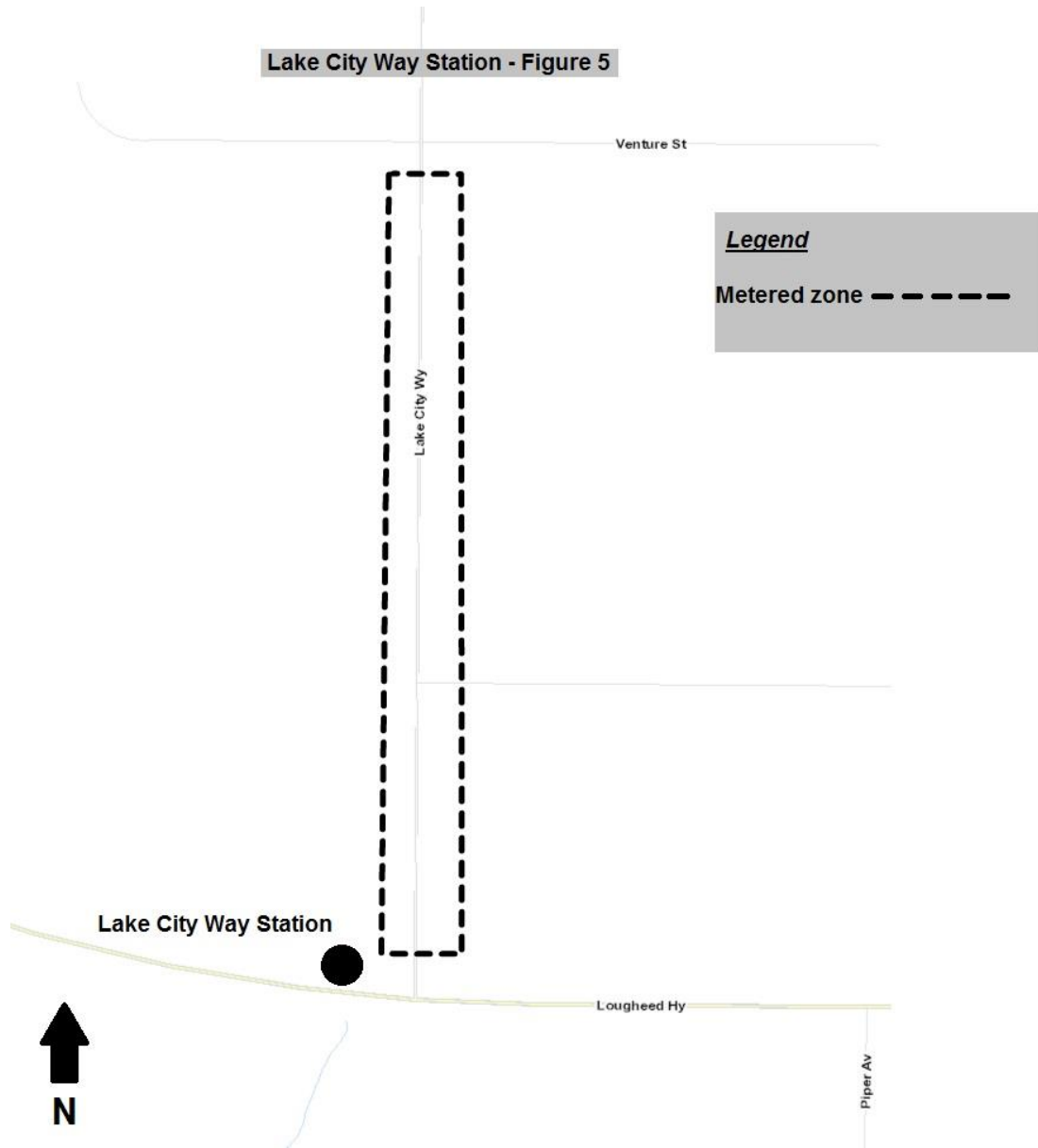




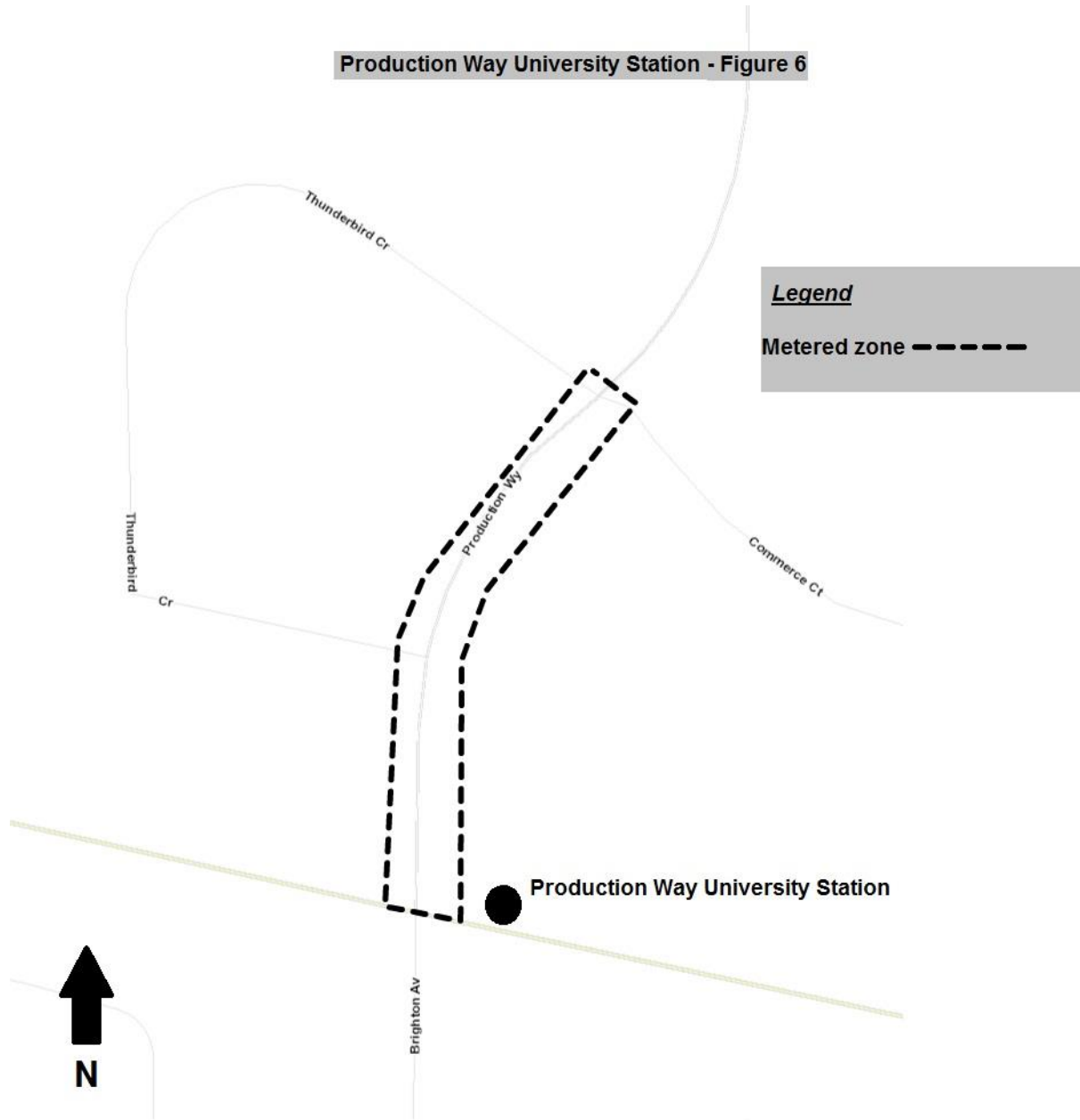
Lougheed Town Centre areas - Figure 4
