Financial Administration Fees and Charges Bylaw 2013 (2021.1)

CITY OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 13157

A BYLAW to set fees and charges for financial administration services

(CONSOLIDATED FOR CONVENIENCE with Bylaw No. 13807 and 14374)

The Council of the City of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw may be cited as **BURNABY FINANCIAL ADMINISTRATION FEES AND CHARGES BYLAW 2013**.
- 2. In this Bylaw, unless to context otherwise requires:
 - (a) "tax information certificates" means a statement regarding the tax status of a property;
 - (b) "mortgage information report" means a statement of taxes owing on one or more properties issued to and at the request of a financial institution or other mortgage lender;
 - (c) "refund" means the refund of any overpayment of taxes;
 - (d) "NSF fee" means a fee charged to cover the administrative costs resulting from dishonoured cheques or payments;
 - (e) "apportionment" means the allocation and apportionment of taxes following the subdivision of a parcel of land to the new parcels created by the subdivision, including strata title subdivision;

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- (f) "historical tax information" means the provision of historical tax or assessment information on a property;
- (g) "Real Estate Board tax information file" means the provision of tax and assessment information on properties made available to the Greater Vancouver Real Estate Board at its request and available for upload to its MLS system; and
- (h) "taxes" includes fees and charges for utility services provided by the City.
- 3. The City of Burnaby imposes fees and charges as specified in Schedule "A".
- 4. Bylaw 12749, being Burnaby Tax Information Certificate Fees Bylaw 2009, is repealed.
- 5. This Bylaw comes into force on the first day of January, 2013.
