Purpose: to regulate and prohibit the discharge of firearms within the Municipality.

THE CORPORATION OF THE DISTRICT OF BURNABY

BYLAW NO. 4669

**A BYLAW to regulate and prohibit the discharge of
firearms within the municipality**

**(Consolidated for convenience with Bylaw No.
5794)**

The Council of The Corporation of the District of Burnaby ENACTS as follows:

1. This Bylaw may be cited as "BURNABY FIREARM REGULATION BYLAW 1964".
- 2.* Repealed.*

BYLAW 5794

3. In this bylaw "firearms" includes air guns, air rifles, air pistols and spring guns.
4. No person shall discharge firearms within the municipality.
- 5.* Notwithstanding Section 4 of this bylaw

BYLAW 5794

- (a) peace officers acting in the execution of their duties may discharge firearms anywhere in the municipality,
 - (b) any person may discharge firearms on a range approved for that purpose by Council,
 - (c) the Officer Commanding Burnaby Detachment Royal Canadian Mounted Police may by permit in writing authorize any person properly licensed and qualified to discharge firearms anywhere in the municipality for the purpose of destroying animals or birds which may or have become a nuisance.*
6. Every person who violates any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be guilty of an offence punishable on summary conviction and liable to a fine not exceeding One Hundred (\$100.00) Dollars or in default of payment to imprisonment for a term not exceeding thirty days.
